

BC Transplant will award four \$1500 scholarships to Grade 10-12 students in the 2024/25 school year. Three of the four scholarships will be awarded to individual student applicants. One of the four scholarships will be designated for a team application.

Logan Boulet, a 21-year old hockey was one of the 16 people killed in the tragic Humboldt Broncos bus crash in 2018. Logan registered as an organ donor just weeks before the accident and had spoken to his father about his wishes a year before. Logan was able to save six people's lives through his organ donation.

As news spread of Logan's selfless act, thousands across the country and world were inspired to register as organ donors. This became known as the "Logan Boulet Effect". To mark the day Logan Boulet became an organ donor, the Boulet family launched Green Shirt Day on April 7.
