

# Navigational Support for Indigenous Patients Referred for Liver Transplant

For Indigenous patients who self-identify and are referred to the liver transplant program by your physician, there are resources available to support you.

An Indigenous Patient Navigator can provide navigational support for you, your family or care provider. They can help you by providing:

- Consultation and health system navigation
- Assistance to support care coordination in the community – by working with healthcare teams to coordinate patient referrals to and from Indigenous organizations and other health programs/services

This support is provided through collaboration with the Indigenous Health teams from [Vancouver Coastal Health](#) and/or the [Provincial Health Services Authority](#) to ensure care services are culturally safe and trauma informed, both in a community (out-patient) setting and in a hospital (in-patient) setting.
